

Cleaning Instructions: Stainless Steel Sinks

Refer to this document for instructions on how to properly clean your **Glide-Lock** stainless steel sink.

Overview:

Rinsing is the most important part of sink care. Your **Glide-Lock** stainless steel sink will retain its original bright appearance if the sink is rinsed thoroughly after each use. This can be done by running water from the faucet spray hose for a few minutes. A rinse and towel-dry after each use takes care of most everyday clean-ups.

Once a week, the sink should be scoured with a non-abrasive cleanser, rubbing in the same direction as the bowl finish (back and forth or a circular motion). This will blend any imperfections into the finish of the sink. Rinse thoroughly, wipe dry, and your sink will shine.

Always:

- Clean every day by thoroughly rinsing with a mild soap and warm water, then wipe dry
- Keep the sink free of any standing water, as this can cause a buildup of mineral deposits, which can affect the appearance of your sink
- If any mineral deposits form on the sink, use a mild solution of vinegar and water, then flush with water
- Remove stubborn stains by gently scrubbing in the direction of the grain with a mild, non-abrasive cleanser, such as a Soft Scrub
- Remove any scratches with a Scotch-Brite pad and cleaning agent
- Rinse the sink after using any cleaning agent, then wipe dry
