

CARE AND CLEANING GUIDE

Daily Vinyl Floor Care

In order to protect your investment Glide-Lock has some simple care tips to help you maintain your luxury vinyl plank flooring.

Glide-Lock luxury vinyl planks are a 100% waterproof flooring option because they won't swell or crack when exposed to water. Nonetheless, you should still remove wet spills as soon as possible.

- Use a white cloth or paper towel to dab the spill and absorb the moisture.
- Use a damp white cloth or paper towel to rinse any spill that isn't water.
- Blot the area dry.

We suggest using a floor cleaner and a microfiber mop or the Hoover floor mate to clean your luxury vinyl plank floors. This daily clean helps to remove dust and debris buildup that can develop over time. Avoid using a traditional mop and bucket since it's easy to spread excess water on the luxury vinyl flooring.

Following this simple daily/weekly routine is all you need to keep luxury vinyl flooring looking its best and staying protected. To further protect floors, use felt pads on furniture bases/legs and be sure to never drag heavy objects along your floors. The Hoover Floormate has also been found to work well in cleaning and maintaining your luxury vinyl plank flooring.

Scratches

In the case where you may have scratched your vinyl plank flooring by moving a heavy object without protectors or a sharp object you can use a flooring or cabinet touch up marker pen in the matching color.

Floor Protectors

Heavy furniture or appliances should be equipped with non-staining floor protectors.

Mats

Use non-staining walk off mats at entrances to prevent dirt and grit from being tracked onto floor. A helpful hint if using a rubber backed mat make sure that the rubber is non-staining and safe to use on vinyl surfaces.
